PRODUCTION AREA

Grape variety: 100% Glera from the commune of Farra di Soligo - Subzone in Col S. Martino, location Castel de Donà - Position: 45° 54' N - 12° 05' E - Cadastral map 8 - Particles: 242, 244, 246, 864, 866, 469, 197°

Terroir: 0,95 hectare vineyard in production since 1900. Average age of vines 75 years. Soil of morainic origin with strong clay presence and partly gravel.

Altitude: 288 - 310m. a.s.l.

Growing method: double arch with 3.100 vines/hectare and 3,5 kg per vine
Yield: Castel de Donà vineyard 2021: 7700 kg

Period of harvest: exclusively by hand on the 21th of September 2021

Produced bottles: 7.328 of 750ml bottles, 180 Magnum

VINIFICATION

Soft pressing of grapes in order to extract the must followed by decanting and clarification of the must. Alcoholic fermentation in a stainless-steel tank at a temperature of 18 °C for approximately 15 days. After that, wine is kept on its noble lees for 30 days and then there will be the filtration

PRISE DE MOUSSE

From the 22nd of February 2022 begins the second fermentation in a small stainless-steel tank adding only raw sugar and selected yeast for approx. 8 months at a temperature of 13 °C -17 °C. Subsequent refinement in the bottle for 90 days before commercialization

CHEMICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Alcohol: 11,79 %

Residual sugar: 0,60 gr/l

CHARACTERISTICS

Nose: clean, effective perfume.

Unique and unexpected notes of citrus softened by floral nuances

Palate: distinctly fresh and penetrating, rendering sensations of pink grapefruit and plum. Personal the important acidity and unexpected persistence

SERVING TEMPERATURE

Between 8° and 10°C
